Our Mobile Unit is **out in the community to host regular pop-ups for Black families**. We provide a variety of support, including health education and screenings, immunizations, COVID-19 testing, lactation consultations, **safe sleep education**, and more!

The inside of the BLACK Mobile Unit **models an exam room to teach doulas in a realistic setting**.

OLIVIA - THE BLACK BIRTHING SIMULATOR

The Mobile Unit can bring Olivia to the community! Olivia "Liv," a state-of-the-art birthing simulator, **provides community and future doula with life-like experiences**.

Liv helps visualize pregnancy stages, birth, and body changes. Liv helps doulas practice necessary skills including comforting measures, practice birth positions, pain relief, advocacy skills, emotional support, caring for baby and more.
